On February 2, 2016, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") issued an order granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity ("Certificate") to Florida Southeast Connection, LLC ("FSC") to construct and operate the proposed Florida Southeast Connection Project ("Project"), *Florida Southeast Connection, LLC, et al.*, 154 FERC ¶ 61,080 (2016). Subsequently, FSC accepted the Certificate and later, pursuant to Certificate Environmental Condition No. 6, filed its Implementation Plan on March 4, 2016.

FSC hereby submits supplemental information to its Initial Implementation Plan. Specifically, pursuant to Condition No. 4, FSC is filing revised construction alignment sheets that incorporate minor pipeline realignments and workspace adjustments as a result of on-going discussions with landowners and agencies or that are the result of various engineering changes that differ from those authorized by the Certificate Order. A table is included herein that identifies each change, whether the change was initiated by a landowner or agency, landowner approval and various other information. All of the changes are within the existing surveyed corridor. None of the changes affect any new landowners or sensitive resources. Accordingly, FSC is not requesting specific approval under Condition No. 5 for any of these changes.
