

CARDIAC – SYMPTOMATIC BRADYCARDIA

Symptomatic bradycardia is defined as a pulse rate < 60 with a systolic BP < 100, with serious signs and symptoms including chest pain, SOB, altered mental status, signs of CHF or hypoperfusion.
