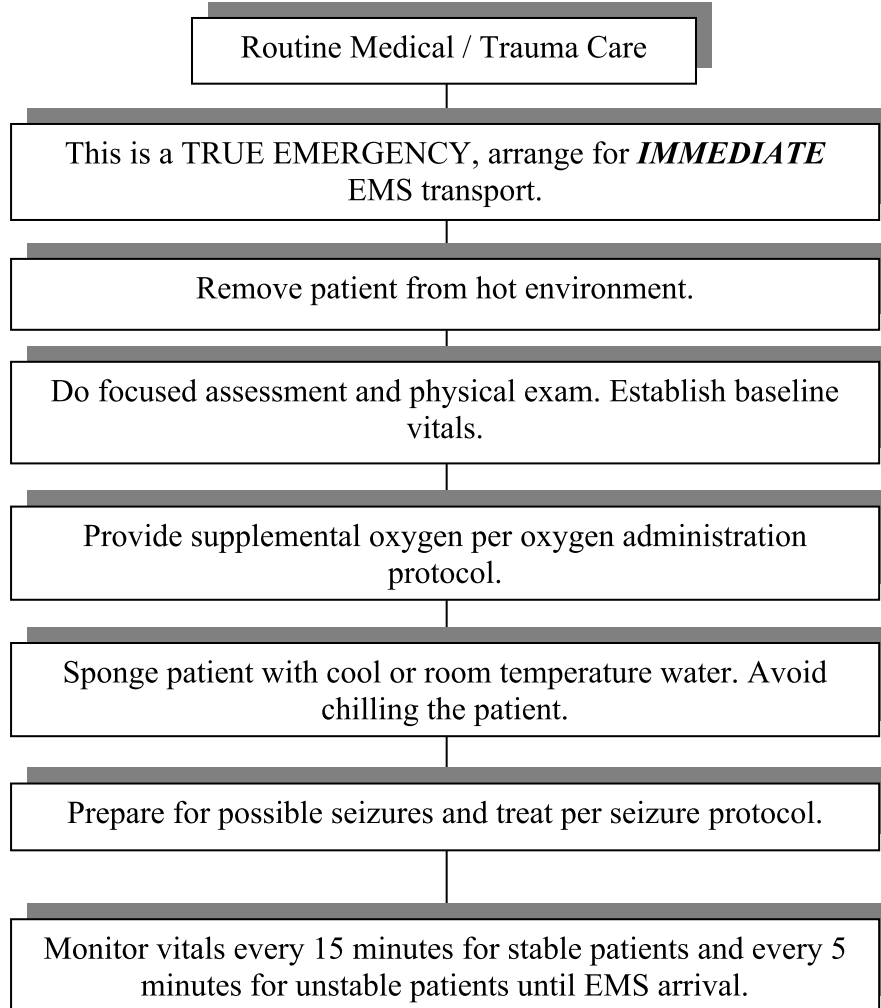


# HEAT STROKE
