Annually update an inventory of water quality-related GI/LID structures located within the permitted area and at a minimum, constructed after December 6, 2012, including the total number of each type of structure (e.g. bioswales, pervious pavement, rain gardens, cisterns, and green roofs). The inventory must, at a minimum, include permittee-owned GI/LID structures, those publicly-owned structures owned by other entities, and privately-owned non-residential GI/LID structures. Track the addition of new water quality-related GI/LID structures through the plan review process and ensure the structures are added to the inventory.</p>
