HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: This case represents a request to rezone approximately 4.73 acres from its

current CON (Conservation) zoning district to M-2 (Heavy Manufacturing) zoning based upon current field data that delineates the actual wetland boundaries.

The subject property is accessed off W Hunt Road, a local County Road created as part of the Perimeter West Industrial Park concept, sitting within the Urban Service Area and Industrial Activity Center character area, and proposed to be served by the City of Valdosta Utilities.

Per the applicant's letter, "the intent of the current zoning map is for the wetland area to be in the CON zoning designation. The zoning map was based off approximate NWI wetland maps. A wetland delineation has been performed by a professional geologist... [and we] request the CON zoning line to be moved to the delineated wetland line."



RE: Re-Zoning Request for Hunt Road Property


The property located on tax map parcel 0158D-004 at the end of Hunt Road is split zoned between CON and M-2. The intent of the current zoning map is for the wetland area to be in the CON zoning designation. The zoning map was based off of approximate NWI wetland maps. A wetland delineation has been performed by a professional geologist and the actual wetland limits are slightly west of the zoning line shown on the zoning maps. This application is being made to request the CON zoning line to be moved to the delineated wetland line. The attached exhibit shows the area that will be re-zoned from CON to M-2.



HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: The pumping capacity of the onsite well at Stone Creek decreased significantly. After consulting with Woodrow Sapp Well Drilling the pump was pulled and inspected. Due to wear, age, and the need to increase capacity, a new pump is recommended. Woodrow Sapp submitted a quote for \$64,095.00 to replace the pump and place the well back in service. 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

COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Lowndes County DUI Court FY 24 Grant Award

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: This award is made under the Accountability Courts State of Georgia grant program. The Lowndes County DUI Court has been awarded a grant by the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council for a total of \$143,063.00, with a 12% match requirement by the county in the amount of \$19,509.00. Lowndes County DUI Court is requesting a total of \$42,404.00 for the 2023-2024 grant period. The grant only pays a portion of the salary and benefits of the surveillance officer's contract salary. Additionally, the grant covers only a portion of treatment costs, transportation, and drug testing supplies incurred annually. The grant does not fund Reconnect, the random call-in service for drug screens. The court requests the shortfall be paid by the DATE funds that are generated from fines and fees collected by the State Court of Lowndes County. The authorizing Georgia Law code section O.C.G.A 15-21-101(b)(3) states "Moneys collected pursuant to this article and placed in the County Drug Abuse Treatment and Education Fund" shall be expended by the governing authority of the county for which the fund is established solely and exclusively (3) if an operating under the influence court division has been established in the county under Code Section 15-1-19, for the purpose of the operating under the influence court division." The Lowndes county DUI Court began operating in January 2017.
