PUBLIC HEARING

Presentation of the Proposed FY 2026 Budget

Finance Director, Stephanie Black, presented an overview of the fiscal year 2026 budget and offered to answer any questions.

Commissioner Marshall inquired about the potential for fuel prices to rise as a result of recent events and asked what measures would be taken to address those increases, should they occur. Ms. Black responded there is some contingency and an estimation of cost based on the history and usage of vehicles.

Commissioner Orenstein asked regarding the fire services budget decreasing by ten percent and asked for clarification. Ms. Black stated the new fire trucks were pulled out of the fire services budget in anticipation of being placed in SPLOST IX. Commissioner Wisenbaker asked if the amount shown in the presentation for fire services was the amount generated from the fire millage, Ms. Black explained that the amounts in the presentation were the expenditures and that the revenues, which include the fire millage, offset those expenditures.

County Manager, Paige Dukes, brought up concerns with the annual assessment notices; to make the commission aware that staff was in the process of researching this matter.

Chairman Slaughter opened the meeting to the public. No one spoke in favor or opposition.
